

CITY OF ROCKY FORD - CITY COUNCIL - SPECIAL MEETING

August 30, 2021

SPECIAL MEETING: 12:30 p.m. - The purpose of the special meeting was to consider, discuss and approve a Resolution to cancel the City of Rocky Ford's participation in the coordinated election on November 2, 2021

Rocky Ford City Council met in special session at 12:30 p.m. on Monday, August 30, 2021 via Zoom. Mayor Susan Jung called the meeting to order. Those in attendance at roll call were:

At the close of business on the sixty-fourth day prior to the date of election, one (1) Mayoral candidate petition was received for the one Mayoral seat and two (2) Councilmember candidate petitions were received for the five (5) Council vacancies. After proper certification, from the City Clerk, there were not more candidates than offices to be filled.

Councilmember Herrera moved to approve and adopt **Resolution #5 – Series 2021 – A Resolution Pursuant to C.R.S. §31-10-507 and The City of Rocky Ford Municipal Code §2-1-30 Cancelling Election.** The motion was seconded by Councilmember Cordova. Councilmember Gurule asked City Manager Wallace to consider budgeting some dollars to use toward community education to help get people involved in civic matters. Discussion was held. Voting results were:
